Valley of the Moon Certified Farmers' Market: The mission of the Valley of the Moon Certified Farmers' Market (VOMCFM) is to provide a venue for certified and local farmers to market diverse, high-quality agricultural products to the local community; to offer healthy food choices from prepared food vendors; and to create an educational forum for consumers to learn the uses and benefits of quality, locally-grown, healthful food. The Market also gives area musicians the chance to perform under the umbrella of a festive community evening unique to the character of this City that beckons locals and tourists to gather together and enjoy the verdant richness of Sonoma life.

<u>VOMCFM Scholarship:</u> The Valley of the Moon Certified Farmers' Market, a non-profit corporation, is offering monetary scholarship(s) to one or more local high school students expecting to study horticulture, viticulture, the culinary arts, or nutrition science.

Eligibility: Scholarship eligibility is reserved for high school students who reside in the Sonoma Valley and who are enrolled in a Sonoma-area high school or equivalent program.

<u>Application Process and Review:</u> Applicants must fill out the VOMCFM Scholarship Application Form and submit a personal essay and a letter of recommendation. Selected finalists may need to appear before our Committee for a personal interview.
